Since the Restaurant Poll's inception in 1989, Jordan wines have received consistently high rankings and inclusions, reaffirming our place on the dinner table of America's finest restaurants.

2020 was the last year *Wine & Spirits* formally ranked the Top 50 Most Popular Wine Brands and instead, retooled their poll to include the top wines that had the most mentions or were the most popular among restaurant staff and guests.

Now in its 34th year, the Restaurant Poll tracks America's shifting tastes and trends—and in turn, has shifted the way the magazine has traditionally tracked the most popular wine brands in restaurants. Sales trends, interviews with prominent wine figures in the U.S. and in-depth analysis of poll data make the annual issue an integral resource for assessing the performance of wine in restaurants and predicting trends. From 1989-2020, restaurants were asked to list their 10 top-selling wines in order of popularity and from 2021-2023, restaurants were asked to list their top three wines that were most mentioned or were considered staff favorites.
