This exclusive Poll canvasses over 2,500 of the most popular restaurants in America (based on Zagat Survey listings) to determine the 50 most popular wine brands in restaurants and the most popular wines by the glass, variety and country of origin. Sales trends, interviews with prominent wine figures in the U.S. and in-depth analysis of poll data make the issue an integral resource for assessing the performance of wine in restaurants, and predicting trends.
